

## ADMISSIONS PROCEDURE

These guidelines will provide you with the most common steps that are followed for international students. There are variances based on country of origin, program required and student objectives so please contact one of our admissions councilors before proceeding.

### BECOMING A STUDENT AT T.I.H.S.

1. Read about our school programs and write us with your questions.
2. You will be asked for a translated summary of your academic records and your University/College or career interests.
3. Once reviewed, we will create a class schedule and budget for your consideration. Any changes required will be agreed and then to the next step.
4. Paperwork. You will need to complete registration forms and send required fees.
5. We will send the materials needed to apply for your Canadian Study Permit and Visa.
6. When you receive your permission to come to Toronto, we will confirm your classes, accomdations and other issues as needed.
7. If you do not receive a Visa all deposits will be returned with an exception of a \$ 200 administration fee.
